Close up exploration of Miranda Kaufmann's historical work "Black Tudors".



A study of the Tudors

A series of mini enquiries exploring the break with Rome, the Mid-Tudor Crisis and the problems of being a woman at this time

How scientific was Europe before the 1800s?

Focus on historical placement and narrative. A mini investigation into medicine, beliefs and science and how this was a turning point in history.



How far was there a revolution in the 17th century

Examination of key features of the cause, events and consequences of the English Civil War. An exploration of the impact on democracy in British history

How did a tiny island take control of a quarter of the world?

An investigation into the slave trade and its impact on society.

Exploration of the role of Britain in establishing the slave trade



How accurate was Dicken's interpretation of Industrial Britain?

A study of the Industrial Revolution through the study of Dickens.



What were the experiences of people during World War One?

A study of the causes of WW1 and how different groups and countries were effected.

What were the causes and effects of the Russian Revolution?

A study into the cause, events and consequences of the revolution. A analysis of the impact of communism on the rest of the world.

An in-depth study of the Holocaust which assesses how treatment of the Jews changed over time and how experiences differed under Nazi rule



Why did fascism flourish in Germany?

In-depth study of Nazi Germany looking at the rise of the Nazis and how Hitler established control.



How far was racism challenged in America between 1945 and 1964

Examination of how racism was challenged by individual people and society. A focus will decide how successful the campaign was



Was it Britain that won World War Two ?

An evaluation of the reasons why Britain won WW2 and how other countries played a part in its victory



The Windrush Generation: How have racial perspectives changed in Windrush in Britain?

An examination of racism in Britain and what, if anything has changed over time



The Cold War: Were we really that close to a nuclear war?

A look at key flash points from the Cold War conflict.
