



On your exam day

Information for Candidates: Written Examinations – Winter 2023

- All exams start at **9:00am** prompt, students must meet in the Theatre at 8:45am to ensure a prompt start to the exam.
- Ensure you know the dates and times for all your exams. Arrive in school at least 15 minutes before the start time of each exam.
- If you arrive late for an exam, report immediately to reception who will notify the Exams Office.

Equipment

- Only take into the exam room the pens, pencils, erasers and any other equipment which you need for the exam.
- You must write clearly and in black ink.
- You must not bring into the exam any notes, an iPod, a mobile phone, an MP3/4 player or similar device, or a watch. Such devices that you have in school should be switched-off and in your bag in advance of entering the exam.
- You may bring a clear bottle of water or clear flavoured water into the exam – it is important the bottle does not have a label on it and is clear.



Malpractice

- Do not become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice during the exam.
- Make sure you stay silent – talking to another candidate could result in disqualification from all your exams.
- If you try cheat or break the rules in any way, you could be disqualified from all your subjects.

Remember: possession of unauthorised material is breaking the rules even if you do not intend to use it, and you will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification.
