We look forward to welcoming Year 11 students on Thursday 22nd August 2024 to receive their examination results. Students can collect their results between 9.00am and 11.00am, from the main reception area. Students are to use the main entrance, on Reading Road, to enter school. Staff will be on hand to guide them through the collection process, from start to finish.

Results can only be collected by the student in person and results cannot be issued by telephone or email.

Parent/carers can only collect results on behalf of their child if they have written consent (click here to download the consent form) from their child, along with ID. This must be previously submitted to Miss Allan, our Examinations Officer, or brought along on results day and verified by Miss Allan, before results can be

If a student is unable to collect their results at the allocated time, results will be posted out on the day. Results will be posted to the address parent/carers have previously provided to the school. Please inform the school office if you have recently moved address and your child is unable to attend on the day to collect their results.

The Joint Council for Qualifications has issued guidance to exam centres and candidates about asking for clerical re-checks and reviews of marking.
